greenlight for girls is an international organisation dedicated to inspire girls of all ages and backgrounds to pursue STEM subjects by introducing them to the world of science in fun and exciting ways.

- greenlight for girls day: Our signature one-day girl-focused event demonstrates the fun in science through hands-on workshops and activities run by volunteer rolemodels in STEM fields. These are events open to the local community and can bring 100-500 attendees with up to 100 volunteers/workshops per event.
- g4g in the community: Our g4g network of volunteers and team participate in local outreach initiatives to encourage girls in STEM education. From Science Fairs, STEM competitions, public sector initiatives and various community events to promote the exposure to science.



- Research studies: In order to learn about the needs in different regions of the world, we conduct research projects to collect data on girls/young women in STEM studies.
- ∞ **g4g Global Scholarship**: Through the generosity of our network, we provide a scholarship to provide university-level education in STEM-related areas to girls in disadvantaged communities around the world.
- g4g Science Library: By encouraging children and parents who attend our events to bring a donated book about science, we are able to collect and ship books to locations around the world that are in desperate need for learning materials.
